Opening Hours

All Year Round - All three schools offer either term time or all year round provision. All year round provision is based at Brookhill Nursery School.

Lunch sessions: - Lunchtime is 11.30-12.30. Hot lunchtime meals are available at St Margaret's Nursery Schools, in the term time only. Children attending in the school holidays will need to bring a packed lunch.

Children staying for lunch at Hampden Way and Brookhill Nursery School will need to bring a packed lunch.

Breakfast and Tea charges include food at all three schools.

Holiday provision is delivered from one of the three BEYA sites with staff that are familiar to your children.

Free Entitlement to Early Education

Three and four year olds;

15 hours for all; all children aged 3-4 years old are entitled to 15 hours free, which can either be taken as 5 morning sessions (8.30-11.30) each week or 5 afternoon sessions (12.30-3.30) each week.

30 hours for some; you may qualify for 30 hours of free childcare if all parent (s) in the household are working:

- at least 16 hours per week and earning at least the minimum wage,
- and your individual earnings do not exceed £100,000 each per year

Term time offer, available at all three schools:

The 30 hours of free entitlement for 3 and 4 year olds will be offered

- 8.30-3.30 -There will be a charge for lunchtime provision of £7 plus £2.30 for a hot meal, per day.
- 9.00-3.00 - There will be a charge of £2.30 for a hot lunch, per day.
- Monday- Thursday 8.30-3.30 and Friday 8.30-11.30 - *one hour free* There will be a charge of £2.30 for a hot lunch, per day.

All year round offer, available at all three schools

Your entitlement can be taken all year round (over 49 weeks at 5 hours per day).

Either an early session (7.30-12.30) Monday to Friday, a hot meal will be charged at £2.30 per day.

Or a late session (12.30-6pm) 30 minutes of provision will be charged at £3.50 per day.

Plus additional sessions purchased as required.

Two year olds - Your 2-year-old may be eligible for 15 hours of free early education and childcare if you receive one of the following:

- income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Universal Credit
- tax credits and you have an annual income of under £16,190 before tax
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- support through part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act
- the Working Tax Credit 4-week run on (the payment you get when you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- they're looked after by a local council
- they have a current statement of special education needs (SEN) or an education, health and care (EHC) plan
- they get Disability Living Allowance
- they've left care under a special guardianship order, child arrangements order, or adoption order

Holiday Provision

We offer all year round provision for children attending our nursery schools. Children from other schools may attend during school holidays. This is available for reception and Year 1 children (4-7 years old).

BEYA Children’s Centre

Children’s Centres offer a range of services to children under five years old and their families.

Some of these services will be delivered at additional venues linked to the Children’s Centres. We deliver a range of services in partnership with other agencies.

- family support and information, including parenting workshops and drop-in groups
- health services and advice including support before and after the birth of a baby
- access to specialist services, for example, speech and language therapy, midwifery support etc
- home visiting to isolated families
- activities for children, mothers, fathers and carers
- learning opportunities for parents and advice on employment
- childminding support groups
- information and advice including benefit information
- Children with additional needs support groups for families
